Sir :-

Replying to your letter of the 28th inst. marked "M" in regard to printing information leaflets for use at the Paris Exposition, I have to say that we will meet your wishes so far as it is practicable for us to do so. There will be no difficulty in printing the English leaflets unless it be in the quantity required, but there will be some difficulty in printing them in French because we do not have the accent letters that are required. As to the number needed, it seems to me they could be printed in lots, and sent forward, the quantity to be gauged somewhat by the demand for them.

If you want us to do what we can in the way of supplying them in English, please advise, as your letter says not to do anything until further notice from you.
