Sir :-

Electa Schenandore, an Oneida, one of our students here was taken ill with typhoid fever while under our outing at Mt. Holly, N. J., and her case had proceeded too far to remove her to Carlisle when it came to my knowledge. It was therefore necessary to have her taken care of at the Burlington County Hospital, for which I now have the bill, 17 weeks at \$7.00 per week,.....\$119.00

Manuel Stewart, living with G. W. Vandegrift, Dolington, Pa., was taken with pneumonia and when it came to my knowledge his case was also too far advanced to remove him. I sent my school physician with instructions to arrange for his proper care. It was best to leave the boy with the family where he was and arrange for a skilled nurse for the time of greatest danger, and place him in care of a competent local physician. I enclose herewith three service vouchers,

Both of these pupils are now at the school and well recovered due in each case to the excellent care received. I approve these several bills and request that I be authorized to pay them as rendered.
