
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir :-

In making the change from our old steam plant to the new we are throwing out three 100 H.P. Star Water Tube boilers and one 40 H.P. Return Tubular boiler, with stack and pipe connections. Two years ago we had to renew the upper 24 feet of the stack which had thoroughly rusted out and was full of holes. The part below that is good and usable for anyone who wants that size, and it is possible I may find someone who needs just such a stack. All this property is now outdoors, and being exposed to the weather will deteriorate in value constantly. I therefore request authority to sell the <sup>lot</sup> either at auction or at private sale if I can find a purchaser, and at the best rate I can.
