
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir :-

On May 21st I received a letter from Agent J. H. Stephens, of Crow Creek, S. Dakota, advising me that Daniel Eagle, an Indian employe at the Grace Boarding School desired to finish his education and recommending him very highly as "a bright intelligent young man, well behaved and of good morals" and asked me to send transportation for him. Without further inquiry as to his age I arranged transportation, and Daniel has just arrived. I now find he is 24 years of age. He seems to be all the agent has said, and as he is already here I request your authority to retain him, notwithstanding he is far beyond the age limit. He lacks several years of being able to graduate, and I can easily arrange that he attend the commercial college in town when he is ready for that, and that is his ambition.
