Sir :-

I hear of a number of eligible pupils in New Mexico who want to come to Carlisle, but it seems necessary to work the field a little through an agent. I therefore desire to send Miss Annie Kowuni, a graduate of Carlisle and also a graduate of Drexel Institute Business College, and now an employe here, whose home is in New Mexico, to see what she can do in the way of gathering up a small party. I shall renominate her for the ensuing year, and while absent on this duty shall necessarily continue her pay. It is necessary at the same time to have someone to fill her place here, as the summer vacation period is our busiest office time.

I therefore request your authority to employ temporarily a stenographer and typewriter for the months of July and August to fill Miss Kowuni's place as clerk at not to exceed the \$30.00 per month which I have asked as her salary next year.
