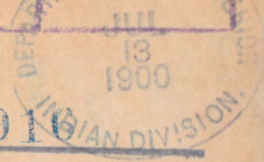


To The Honorable,

Sir :-

We have an unusual amount of work to do during July and August, and it is important that we keep a considerable number of our best working pupils, both mechanics and laborers, to get things into shape for the opening of school in the fall. As these young people could all go out and earn good wages on farms, it is not fair I should keep them here without paying them. I therefore respectfully request your authority to expend for student labor, mechanical, agricultural, etc. at prices from .10 to .75 c. a da \$2000.00 or as much thereof as may be necessary.
