The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir :-

It was impossible for me to erect the brick stack before the end of June. We have the brick on hand and the foundation is laid, but all the brick are yet to be laid. I am therefore compelled to ask a renewal of a part of the authority for the stack. We are compelled to remodel and enlarge the boiler house to suit the increased boiler power. I therefore respectfully request your authority to expend in pay for labor in laying stone and brick both in the stack and walls of the addition to the house and for additional carpenter and other skilled labor needed in remodeling the boiler house, refitting steam pipes, etc. and for equipping the stack with cast iron cap with lead flashings, etc. and for cement and other material, the sum of.....\$1500.00
