The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir :-

In accordance with an agreement between the Government and the Gas & Water Co., of Carlisle, Pa. in 1885, I respectfully request authority to expend during the current fiscal year for the water supply for this school \$240.00

I also respectfully request authority to expend in the purchase of postage stamps for students' correspondence ... 100.00

and in payment of telephone rent for the current year..... 149.00

Total \$489.00

In explanation of this increase for service of telephones, the Southern Penna. Company has established a local service in this and the near-by towns, covering in Carlisle alone nearly three times as many subscribers as the Penna. Tel. Co. I can have an office service at \$24.00 a year and service with the lower farm three miles distant at the same price. I ask your approval and the \$48.00 a year added to cover this new and valuable service. If the new company had long distance service, we might do away with the Penna. Telephone service, and this change is likely to come in the near future.
