
Sir:-

Your letter of June 22nd, marked "Finance Ann. Estimate" 1901, authorizing me to purchase sundry articles in open market, contains the following in regard to the purchase of 9,000 yds. Prod-
igy check; viz:-

XXX "In this connection I desire to state that the foregoing list covers all items in your annual estimates not scheduled for delivery under contract or included in Office letter of May 17th, Authority 65680, except the additional articles found on your medical and school estimates, and 9,000 yds. of apron check, all of which may be made subjects of separate communications when the articles embraced therein are required." I have the honor to state in regard to the check that I have obtained samples and bids from dealers in New York, Phila. and Carlisle, and submit herewith a schedule of bids received.
