
Sir:-

Replying to your letter of education marked 35,682 in reference to Mrs. Jones, I have to respectfully advise you that Mrs. Jones was Miss Cora Snyder a graduate of class 1896. Since that time she has had an appointment in the Indian Service but, I believe, failed to give satisfaction.

Her statement that she took a course in Kindergarten while here is erroneous. We never gave Kindergarten Methods. We have a Normal Course and Mrs. Jones did take something of that.

I think it would be better to let her appointment be governed by her success in the reports of hersent to the Indian Office.
