

Sir:-

Referring to my explanations over phone last evening and this morning and my telegram to-day, the bids made were for delivering in coal-house. It will be necessary for us to haul the coal as the \$2.40 per ton only covers delivery on our siding.

We have all our teams in full use. I therefore request authority to have the coal hauled from our siding to coal-house at not to exceed twenty cents per ton. Two hundred and forty dollars. This expense included, we save forty-three cents per ton, presuming we accepted the lowest bid of \$3.03 per ton, ^{or} six hundred and eighty-eight dollars on the whole 1600 tons.
