Sir:-

Replying to your letter of the 10th inst. marked "Education 38609-1900" with enclosure, in regard to the return home of James Lock, I have to say, that James entered this school in Sept. 1895; that for a long time he was unsatisfactory as a student, causing trouble by running away etc; and that he is at the present time in debt to the school \$26.00 for expense incurred in these escapades. He should liquidate at least a part of this debt which he may be able to do from his earnings of this season, he being at present at work in the country. It is fair to say that for the last year James has been doing better, but unless some special reason exists for his return home, at the present time I think he would be best off at school until next spring.
