Sir:-

We have a Remington typewriter which after ten years of service has become much worn, and is not equal to doing good work; has been several times repaired but is an old machine. We have also another Remington that is a good machine but needs overhauling. I have corresponded with the Remington people in regard to an exchange and they will allow \$35.00 for the old machine in exchange for a new one, allowing the school 10 per cent. discount on the price of the new machine, making \$55.00 in addition to the old machine as the cost of a new one; and to completely overhaul the other one for \$16.00 I therefore respectfully request authority to expend \$71.00 in the exchange and repair of typewriters as above stated.
