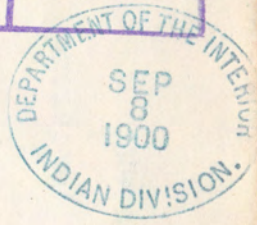



Sir:-

On my quarterly estimate for the current quarter, I asked authority to purchase eight bushels of timothy seed at not to exceed \$2.00 per bushel. On the quotations given by dealers at the time, this estimate allowed a good margin. As the time comes to make the purchase, I find there has been a very material advance in the price and it cannot now be bought at less than \$2.20 per bushel with the price still unsettled and advancing.

Owing to the purchase of an adjoining farm, for school use seven bushels additional will be needed. I therefore ask your authority to buy seven bushels of timothy seed at not to exceed \$2.20 per bushel and that my authority on the eight bushels be amended to read at not to exceed \$2.20 per bushel instead of \$2.00; in all \$17.00.
