

Referring to my letter of Sept. 10th requesting permanent position for domestic science teacher, I have now to respectfully inform you that I find Miss Minnie L. Ferree, now employed in that capacity in the Home for Self-supporting Women on Wesley Ave., Cincinnati, Ohio, offers the best equipment for the place. I therefore respectfully request authority to employ her as domestic science teacher at this school, and as it is the only position of the kind in the Indian service perhaps it can be arranged later that a special examination be held.

Miss Ferree served in Christ's Hospital, Cincinnati for some time. Prior to that she was matron and instructor in cooking in the Williamsburg Academy at Williamsburg, Ky.; she was also so employed in a girls' school in North Carolina. From all these places she has very high testimonials not only for her qualities and ability in her special line, but also as to character; so that I now feel confident of having the person I have been looking for.
