

Sir :-

I have been endeavoring to secure dried fruit. It is yet a little early, and we have bought a small quantity to tide over. Indications are that dried fruit will be high. It will not be less economical and will be more wholesome to buy fresh apples, as I find I can get an excellent article in New York at \$1.25 a barrel.

I therefore respectfully request authority to buy in open market 150 barrels, 2 1/2 bushels in a barrel, of superior fall and winter apples at not to exceed \$1.25 a barrel, and will then deduct a proportionate amount from my dried fruit purchases when made.
