
To The Honorable,

Sir:-

I have still one vacant position as teacher at \$540, Mr. Odell having reported yesterday. Mrs. Odell is a teacher of ten years experience less the time that she took to complete her course in a normal school and to take a kindergarten course. She taught in the Indian Service at Hoopa., California, very acceptably as I understand from a letter from the former Agent, Captain Dougherty. She has applied to the civil service commission to take the teachers' examination in October and is awaiting her notification. From the short acquaintance and her testimonials, I am satisfied that she would make us a worthy teacher, and I request permission to appoint her temporarily to the position at \$540, and if she succeeds in passing the examination and can get on the eligible list, it may be arranged that she can continue here if satisfactory.
