Our school desks have been in use from ten to thirteen years and have become very much soiled and scarred. I corresponded with the manufacturer who came down in person, and after looking at them said he would send an expert to varnish and finish them, furnishing varnish and all material needed to clean them, at 15 cents each.

I therefore respectfully request authority to expend in varnishing and cleaning 800 desks.....\$120.00


