The Indians have no more cattle since Capt. J. W. Cooke left the Agency. Our people are fallen back six years and the Department cut the rations down to two and half pounds of flour and beef.

I wish you do me a favor to try and get me a work farmer butcher at this Agency.

Will send the money as soon as I get the chance to sell a steer.
