

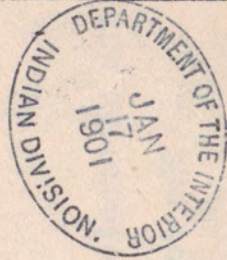



Sir:-

In order that our stock of uniform clothing may be ample, I respectfully request your authority to expend for the making of coats and pants by outside labor, and for the other purposes mentioned the following amounts during the current fiscal year. Viz:-

For making 100 uniform coats at \$1.00 each - - - -	\$100.00
For making 200 pairs Pants at 50 cents each, - - - -	100.00
For the purchase in open market of farm and garden seeds and plants including Clover and Grass Seeds, etc.- - -	200.00
For postage for pupils' Correspondence etc. - - - -	100.00
