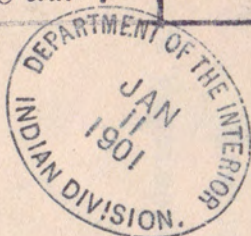

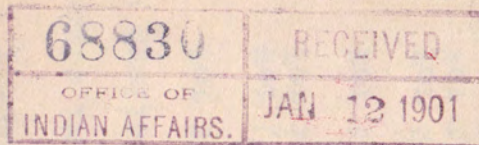


Sir:-

I respectfully request your authority to expend the following amounts in paying for the installation of electric lights in the two new dwellings recently erected and for the other purposes specified. Viz:

For installing (29) Electric Lights in the new dwellings at \$2.00 each, - - - - -	\$58.00
For (5) twolight Chandeliers at \$1.50 each, - - - - -	7.50
For installing (15) additional lamps at the shops, hospital and boiler house at \$1.50 each, - - - - -	22.50
For the purchase of 200 Electric Light Bulbs, 10 and 16 c. p. at 16 cents each, - - - - -	32.00
For the purchase of 100 Bulbs, frosted at 22 cents, - - - - -	22.00
For the purchase of twenty bags of Asbestos Cement for covering pipes at \$2.25 per bag, - - - - -	45.00
For incidental repairs to buildings, sewerage, water, steam and light systems, machinery etc., during current fiscal year, - - - - -	300.00

The above electric lights come within the limits of our contract and do not add anything to the annual charge for electric current.
