
To The Honorable,

Sir :-

I have made it a point ever since the establishment of this school to require students to pay their own dental bills where they had the money, and where they had not the money have heretofore found the means myself. The increased size of the school and the large number of students who are too small to earn money or have not been here long enough to do so, have made this expense considerable of a burden, and I think best that the school appropriation stand that portion covered by those belonging to the class mentioned above.

I therefore respectfully request authority to pay from the school appropriation as may be necessary during the balance of the fiscal year, not to exceed \$100, such dental bills, extraction, filling, etc. of this sort as may occur.
