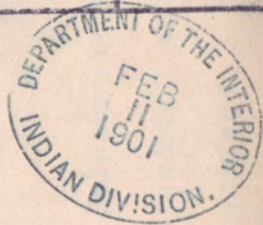



Sir :-

In connection with our outing it has been my habit to require students to purchase their own trunks. We have this difficulty that many of the new students who have not had an opportunity to earn money, have nothing to buy with. To overcome that, I respectfully request authority to buy 100 telescope valises at not to exceed \$1.00 each \$100.00, these valises to remain the property of the school and to be used by pupils who have not the money to buy trunks when they go to the country. When they have earned enough money to buy trunks, the valises will be returned to the school for the use of other pupils.
