Replying to your letter of the 26th inst. marked "M" in regard to Miss Johnston coming to Carlisle to take photographs for the Buffalo Exhibit, I have to say that it would not be convenient to undertake this work until after our commencement. There will be some changes in classes but by the 20th of March things will be so settled as to be in good shape for her work. I therefore suggest that she come to Carlisle about Tuesday the 19th. She can be accommodated with a room at the school and board at the teacher's club as arranged. I presume she will be able to obtain ordinary photographic supplies in Carlisle.
