Sir:-


In handling the work of our farms especially the one at a distance, it becomes necessary to use some all day workers, the bulk of the work at the new farms being done by those who work one-half of each day and go to school the other half, but this is not practicable for all; I therefore request authority to pay a small salary to two all day workers at each farm, six in all, viz:-

2 at \$10.00 per month each for the quarter, - - -	\$60.00
4 at 8.00 per month each for the quarter, - - -	96.00

I find also that owing to the large number of apprentices who have gone to the country for the summer, that our supply of shoes made at our own shop will probably be insufficient; I therefore ask authority to expend in the open market purchase of 200 pairs of boys and girls shoes, a sum not to exceed, - - - -
