

Sir:-

Last fall we bought enough potatoes to see us well through the winter, intending to buy an additional supply in the spring.

I find that to make out a sufficiency for kitchen use and for planting we shall need about (300) bushels more; these can now be bought for 47¢ per bushel. I therefore respectfully request your authority to buy in open market 300 bushels of potatoes at not to exceed 47 cents per bushel, expending the sum of \$141.00.
