The additions coming into the school just now and the extra demands upon us in furnishing and clothing boys whom we have sent to the country have reduced our supplies of shoes, hats, and clothing to such an extent that I need to purchase at once.

I respectfully request authority to purchase in open market

250 pairs Boys' shoes at not to exceed \$1.35 a pair.....	\$337.50
<i>disk</i> 200 Felt hats for boys at not to exceed 75¢ each....	150.00
10 dozen Collars, turned down, at not to exceed \$1.10 per dozen.....	11.00
