

Sir:-

Harrison Waterman, a pupil of this school, has for some time been suffering with diseased eyes to such an extent that it became necessary to send him to Philadelphia for special treatment in order to save his sight. I accordingly sent him to the Medico-Chirurgical Hospital where he remained seven weeks and two days, receiving treatment free, the only charge being for his board at \$7.00 per week. I forward herewith the board bill of \$51.00 and voucher for same, and another voucher showing an expense of \$11.90 incurred by S. L. Diven, my school physician, in taking this boy to the hospital, making a total expense of \$62.90.

I respectfully request authority to pay these amounts from government funds.
