
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:-

Our dining room which was constructed for the accommodation of 600 pupils to be seated at the tables at one time is too small for the 700 which we carried most of the time last winter and should be enlarged before school opens in the fall. I propose a cheap addition in the northwest angle of one story, 44-6 x 32 ft. This necessitates only one side and one end. There should be an 8 foot cellar underneath which should be cemented bottom and sides. To make this improvement would require an expenditure not to exceed seven hundred fifty (\$750) dollars in the purchase of lumber, lath, excavating, quarrying and laying of stone, for mortar, brick and laying of same, iron rods, carpenter work, cement hardware and painting. As I propose to do this work largely with student labor and the emergency of getting it completed within two months is upon us, I trust it may be treated as an emergency matter and I be authorized to expend for the purchases and payments as above noted the sum named.
