
To The Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir :-

On a more careful examination of the house and out buildings at the Kutz farm just purchased, I find that the walls of the main building are cracked and need repair; that the roof is rotten and ought to be replaced; the brick walls are put on a stone foundation and at some places are beneath the surface, which is bad. The cellar is too low and cramped. The building was erected early in the last century. The foundation wall ought to be a foot above the surface of the ground and the stories at least a foot higher than they are now, only 8 feet.

I respectfully request authority to tear down the present building and erect a new one in which I can use in part lumber and brick already delivered on contract, and such of the old material as is fit, there being enough to considerably lessen the expense. To enable me to do this work I respectfully request authority to expend in the open market purchase of additional material, brick, lime, sand, quarrying stone, laying of same, lumber, door, window and sash frames, labor, painting, etc. the sum of\$500.00
