Sir:

In reply to "Education, 43375-1901" dated Aug. 13th 1901, I will state that there is a payment due the Indians at this Agency, being the principal of the Siletz General Fund. Robert Depoe, the young man referred to in your letter will be a participant in this payment. I do not know when this payment is to be made - D. W. Manchester, Special U. S. Indian Agent has been here for that purpose since last December - nor whether the money due the Superintendent of the Carlisle Indian School can be guaranteed to him out of this payment except as Robert Depoe chooses so to apply it.

I am informed that Depoe is employed as a teacher in the Chemawa Indian School, Salem, Oregon, and it seems

his indebtedness to the Superintendent
of the Carlisle School or make an
explanation acceptable to your office.
