Sir:-

Referring to your letter dated Sept. 10th., marked "Finance 37195-1901", in reference to buckboards, I have to respectfully advise you that in accordance with directions contained in your letter of April 10th, 1900, marked "Finance 13945, 10050, 16847-1900, Auth. 65046", I delivered five buckboards at the Indian Warehouse New York, at \$57.00 each.

My letter of Sept. 4th, quoted price of \$61.50 for the same kind of a buckboard delivered at the Chicago warehouse, the difference in price being accounted for by the additional freight charges to Chicago.

The blue-print of the two-seated buckboard sent you with my letter of Sept. 4th., is from a photograph taken of those built for the Kiowa Agency. I enclose another blue print of the same.
