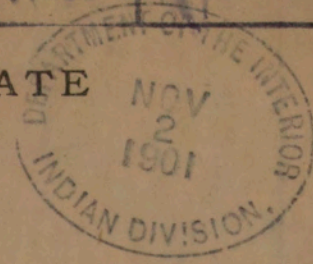

To the Commissioner of Indian Affairs:

*Sir: I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, &c., required for the service at the school agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$ 426 43, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same (1) in open market*

*I also ask authority to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals in the case, in the (2)*

*and to make contract with the lowest responsible bidder, or bidders, for the delivery of the articles estimated for.*

*I have on hand (3) \$ available to the proposed purchase, from appropriation*

The application to be made of each article, and the necessity for its purchase, must be clearly stated in the remarks. Insert extra leaves when the space is not sufficient.
