Sir :-

Referring to your letter of the 6th inst. marked "Education 60584", I have to respectfully advise you that Agent Monteath of the Blackfeet Agency has been notified that Henry Lahr is not a desirable pupil nor worthy of further Indian school privileges, and have included him in a list of runaways sent to superintendents of non-reservation schools, which list is as follows :-
