Sir :-

Replying to Office letter #63873, 1901, bearing date of Nov. 14, 1901, in reference to the application of the Supt. of the Moqui School for two of our girls for employment at the Oraibi Day School, I have the honor to recommend Ella Sturm and Nellie Orme, either of whom would be suitable for the position of housekeeper, but neither of whom I would recommend for laundress and cook. After commencement we may have several who could fill such positions.

Ella Sturm is at present at her home at Cobb, Okla, but lately applied for a position, her application being forwarded to your office with recommendation that she be given an appointment. Nellie Orme was lately sent to the Sacaton School on account of delicate health, but could probably fill a position very well in the southwest where the climatic conditions are favorable to her ailment. However, if Ella Sturm has not been selected by your office for some other place I would prefer that she take the place and have already written that if she desires to go to Oraibi she should report there at once.
