

Sir:

I have the honor to forward herewith a voucher for expenses amounting to \$22.55 incurred by S.L. Diven, my school physician, in taking five pupils of this school to the Medico-Chirurgical Hospital, Philadelphia, for special treatment of eyes and other troubles which could not be successfully treated here.

I also enclose a voucher for reimbursement of \$21.00 advanced to pay board for Maggie Escacerga, one of the pupils in this party. The other pupils have sufficient funds of their own to pay their board bills while at the hospital, and two were able to refund the amounts paid for their railroad fare, as shown on the sub voucher. As the personal funds of these five pupils are insufficient to cover the expenses shown on these two vouchers, I respectfully request authority to pay the same from Government funds.
