
To The Honorable,

In asking for eligibles to fill the position of Outing Agent at this school, I have the honor to suggest that in order to fill the position properly the incumbent must have a thorough knowledge of the people and localities where our students are placed. This knowledge cannot be gained without a considerable residence here. The facts stated in my communication of the 7th instant concerning our Girls' Manager apply also in the case of the Outing Agent, as the Girls' Manager has charge of the girls in country homes and the Outing Agent of the boys.
