
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

In asking authority to retain at the school those members of the senior class who are not more than one eighth Indian I inadvertently omitted the name of Oscar Davis, a Chippewa from White Earth, Minn. Oscar came to us a small boy, beginning in one of the lower grades six years ago. He is bright and capable and has advanced rapidly. It is his desire to complete the course and on account of his good qualities I shall be glad if he can be allowed to do that, although he falls under your order of discharge, being only one eighth Indian. He will graduate in February next.
