

Replying to yours of May 24th marked "Education , 22912 - 29026"
I have to respectfully advise you that my assistant, Mr. Allen, in-
forms me that Miss Frances R. Scales who resigned the position of
principal teacher at the Seneca school, I. T. in December, 1901, and
is now at Reidsville, N. Carolina, is a good teacher, and recommends
her. Accordingly I directed that he write her suggesting that she re-
quest reinstatement in the service with a view to appointment at Car-
