
Sir :

Referring to my letter to you of May 20th in regard to the position of domestic science teacher here, I enclose a letter received from Miss Mary E. Richardson of Brooklyn, New York, who acting under my suggestion applied to the Civil Service Commission to take the examination for domestic science teacher at this school. It will be seen that her reply from the Commission advises that no such examination is to be held.

I trust this matter will be adjusted and that we may have a skilled domestic science teacher ; that Miss Ferree as well as any other candidates be required to take the examination therefor, and that the position be upon a permanent basis.
