

Sir :

Replying to yours of the 11th instant marked "Education 38941" covering application of Eva Rogers for appointment in the Indian service, I have to respectfully advise you that Eva did not graduate at Carlisle but was entitled to receive a diploma because of her work outside the school. She left the senior class here to attend Perkiomen Seminary at Pennsburg, Pa., working her own way by waiting on tables, and doing other work about the school, until she had really passed beyond our curriculum in some things. She is a young woman of rather positive character and I am told by my matrons that she has very considerable influence with the other girls in directing and managing. She would, I think, make a useful assistant matron.
