It is agreed between the sender of the message written on the face hereof and the Postal Telegraph-Cable Company that said Company shall not be liable for mistakes or delays in the transmission or delivery, or for non-delivery of any **UNREPEATED** message, beyond the amount received for sending the same; nor for mistakes or delays in the sending the same, unless specially insured, nor in any case for a loss arising from the unavoidable interruption in the working of its lines, or for errors in cipher or obscure messages. And the Company hereby made the agent of the sender, without liability to forward any message over the line of other Company when necessary to reach its destination.

Correctness in the transmission of messages to any point on the lines of the Company can be insured by contract in writing, stating agreed amounts of risk, and payment or premium thereon, at the following rates, in addition to the usual charge for repeated messages: viz: one per cent for a distance not exceeding 1,000 miles, and two per cent, for an **extra day's** distance.

No responsibility regarding messages attached to this Company until the time are presented and accepted at one of its transmitting offices; and no message is sent to such office until the time of the Company's messenger, but acts for that purpose as the agent of the sender.

Messages will be delivered to the within the established free delivery limits of the several offices. For delivery at a greater distance a special charge will be made to cover the cost of such delivery.

This Company will not be liable for damages or statutory penalties in any case where the claim is not presented in writing within sixty days after the message is filed with the company for transmission.

This is an **UNREPEATED** Message and is delivered by request of the sender under the conditions named above. Errors can be guarded against by repeating a message, as to the sending station for comparison.
