

Sir :

On Aug. 19th I wrote you requesting a change in positions here that would give me Miss Bowersox as Assistant Principal and Normal Teacher at a salary of \$1,000. I have since spoken to you over phone about it and in writing you Aug. 20th officially and on Sept. 17th and Sept. 20th personally I mentioned it. I have not received this authority. The delay indicates embarrassment. To relieve the situation I respectfully request to recall my said letter of the 19th of August and to leave the position as it now stands, Normal Teacher at \$720, and I will continue to use Miss Bowersox in the position proposed; and in order that she may be encouraged and not disappointed I will pay from other funds the difference between her present salary and the proposed salary.
