Replying to Office letter "Education 63,050 - 1902" dated Oct. 25th, I have the honor to state that the proper average attendance for the quarter ending September 30th is 874.3, as shown by the monthly reports. Our Quarterly Reports show the number remaining at the school at the end of September to be 882, which is also correct. It is not the average attendance however. In fact, the average is not shown upon the Quarterly Report. We obtain it by dividing the sum of the monthly averages by 3.
