Replying to Office communication of the 11th instant, marked "Education 9013 - 1903", calling for the record of John Thomas and Ralph Ovieta, both of Pima Agency, the following is taken from our records :

Juan Thomas Wayhama ; Pima ; Pima Agency, Arizona. father's name, Wayhamae; mother dead; full Indian ; age 17 ; entered Carlisle Feb. 25, 1895 for 5 years ; discharged June 26, 1900; time out.

Ralph Ovieta ; Pima ; Pima Agency, Arizona ; father living; mother dead; full Indian ; age, 16 ; entered Carlisle Feb. 25, 1895 for 5 years; discharged July 6, 1901; time out.

Both had country experience under our outing; while at the school Ralph had training in our carpenter shop and Juan in the tailor shop.
