

Replying to Office communication of the 11th instant marked "Education, 8335 - 1903" in regard to Robert McArthur, a quarter-blood Chippewa of White Earth, Minnesota, I have to respectfully advise you that the young man entered this school Aug. 25th, 1897 and was discharged June 30th, 1900, re-entered March 1st, 1901 and was again discharged Sept. 4th, 1901. Though near graduation his character was such as to lead me to let him go without a diploma. Since leaving Carlisle it has been represented to me that he is doing well, and he has ability.
