Sir:-

I have the honor to inform you that in December last George Bear's Arm, a pupil of this school, underwent an operation in our school hospital for appendicitis. His condition appeared to be improved for a time, but soon became quite critical, whereupon I sent him to the German Hospital, Philadelphia, for another operation and treatment. He remained in the German Hospital from December 31, 1902, to January 6, 1903, at which time he died.

The expenses incident to taking this young man to Philadelphia, visiting and caring for him in the hospital and in bringing the corpse back to Carlisle amounted to \$69.43, as is evidenced by the three vouchers submitted herewith for approval.
