
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir :

Miss Annie B. Moore, instrumental music teacher, leaves us at the close of the year to be married. Miss Senseney, our present vocal instructor, would like at least a temporary change, and I have concluded to give her the place of instrumental instructor and let Mr. Davies, who seems to have specially fitted himself for the teaching of music, take the position of vocal instructor, which will be a promotion for him. This will create a vacancy in the teaching force and I now respectfully request to be provided with a good male teacher to take Mr. Davies' place in the school-room at a salary of \$540 per annum. I make the request thus early, hoping by so doing to improve our chance for getting a suitable teacher. He can report at any time after the first of July, though not necessarily before the first of September.
