
To the Honorable,

Sir:-

Referring to my letter of the 15th and your reply of the 19th, Education 31152-1903, covering Miss Daisy C. Laird's resignation and the selection of a male teacher in her place, I have to respectfully advise you that in securing eligibles from the civil Service, it seems to me best that they should come in at the lower salaries, and those teachers we have tried and who have proven satisfactory have increased salaries. I therefore request that the male teachers selected be for the \$540. places and I will nominate present employees to fill the \$600. places.
