

Sir:-

Miss Jessie McIntire, teacher of our Normal department, has resigned to take effect the end of June. That department needs a Normal trained teacher, specially qualified not only by training but by experience. Miss Emma K. Hetrick of West Hanover, Pennsylvania seems to have the qualities required. She is on the eligible list and has already been certified twice. I request she be appointed to fill Miss McIntire's place. As she is just entering the Service I think it well to give her one of the \$540 places and to promote a teacher who has served us the past year. She can report any time between the 1st of July and 1st of September.
